RULES

COMPETITION AIMS

To encourage senior YFC members to reflect and evaluate their contributions and achievements in YFC and the wider community through an application and interview process.

To encourage senior YFC members to take on an ambassadorial role on behalf of the federation and share their experiences as a Young Farmer

LEARNING OUTCOMES

Communication skills, presentation skills and personal development skills

1. **DATE & VENUE** – Agriculture House Gloucester.8pm Wednesday 8th February 2012. Closing date for entries and synopsis on or before Friday 27th January 2012

2. **ELIGIBILITY** - The competitor must be 18 year or over and under 26 years or under on 1 September 2011 and a full member of a Club affiliated to the NFYFC.

Competitors are required *in person* to produce on the day of each round of the competition (County and National) their current and signed Membership Card, with suitable photo-ID.

3. **HEALTH & SAFETY & SAFEGUARDING** – All competitions carried out at every level must comply with Health and Safety and Safeguarding legislation and meet the relevant safety standards.

4. PROCEDURE

PART 1

Two weeks prior to the County Final, competitors will be required to complete their completed Synopsis Form, which will show details of their YFC activities to the GFYFC County Office. (Special emphasis should be placed on their involvement at Club level).

PART 2

Competitors will be interviewed at the County Final by a panel of Judges, in an informal atmosphere.

PART 3

All competitors will be interviewed briefly on stage, in an audience situation at the County Final.

5. **OBJECTIVES** - The objective of the competition is to select a member who has shown that they are involved in all aspects of the YFC Movement. Judges will be looking for:-

- *Involvement at club level for period of membership*
- *Overall YFC involvement (i.e. club, county, area or national)*
- *Specific involvement in activities in the previous 12 months (conservation, competitions, recruitment, programming, charity, sport, club officer)*
- *General commitment to YFC - awareness of fellow members' interests in YFC and objective view of the future of the organisation*

- *Knowledge of the YFC at Club, County, Area and National levels and to share that knowledge over the 12 month period following the final*
